ORDER IN COUNCIL

At the Government House at Wellington this 20th day of July 1981

Present:

HIS EXCELLENCY THE GOVERNOR-GENERAL IN COUNCIL

PURSUANT to sections 61 and 83 of the Meat Act 1964, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, hereby makes the following regulations.

REGULATIONS

1. Title and commencement—(1) These regulations may be cited as the Game Regulations 1975, Amendment No. 3, and shall be read together with and deemed part of the Game Regulations 1975* (hereinafter referred to as the principal regulations).

(2) These regulations shall come into force on the 14th day after the date of their notification in the *Gazette*.

2. Removal of economic criteria in considering grant of licence—

(1) Regulation 10 of the principal regulations is hereby amended—

(a) By revoking paragraph (b) (v) of subclause (1):

(b) By revoking subclause (2).

(2) Regulation 14 (3) (b) (ii) of the principal regulations is hereby amended by omitting the expression “(ii) to (v)”, and substituting the expression “(ii) to (iv)”.

(3) Regulation 20 of the principal regulations is hereby revoked.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

This note is not part of the regulations, but is intended to indicate their general effect.

These regulations amend the Game Regulations 1975.

The effects of the amendments are to remove the economic considerations from those matters that are to be taken into account when issuing a licence.
