1. Title—This order may be cited as the Government Railways Amendment Act Commencement Order 1972.

2. Commencement of section 2 of the Government Railways Amendment Act 1971—Section 2 of the Government Railways Amendment Act 1971 shall come into force on the 1st day of June 1972.
