PURSUANT to section 1 (2) of the Government Railways Amendment Act 1980, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, hereby makes the following order.

ORDER

1. Title—This order may be cited as the Government Railways Amendment Act Commencement Order 1981.

2. Commencement of sections 2 and 6 of the Government Railways Amendment Act 1980—Sections 2 and 6 of the Government Railways Amendment Act 1980 shall come into force on the 1st day of April 1981.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

This note is not part of the order, but is intended to indicate its general effect.

This order brings into force the provisions relating to the appointment to the permanent staff of apprentices and the appointment of officers to certain higher positions in the Government Railways Department.
