ORDER IN COUNCIL

At the Government House at Wellington, this 10th day of December 1952

Present:

HIS EXCELLENCY THE GOVERNOR-GENERAL IN COUNCIL

PURSUANT to the Government Railways Act 1949, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, hereby makes the following regulations.

REGULATIONS

1. (1) These regulations may be cited as the Government Railways Classification and Pay Regulations 1942, Amendment No. 12, and shall be read together with and deemed part of the Government Railways Classification and Pay Regulations 1942* (hereinafter referred to as the principal regulations).

(2) These regulations shall be deemed to have come into force on the 1st day of September 1952.

2. The principal regulations are hereby amended by revoking the First Schedule, as substituted by regulation 6 of the Government Railways Classification and Pay Regulations 1942, Amendment No. 11, and substituting the First Schedule set out in the Schedule to these regulations.
