Pursuant to the Government Railways Act, 1926, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, doth hereby make the following regulations.

REGULATIONS

- 1. These regulations may be cited as the Government Railways Classification and Pay Regulations 1942, Amendment No. 5, and shall be read together with and deemed part of the Government Railways Classification and Pay Regulations 1942* (hereinafter referred to as the principal regulations).
- 2. The principal regulations are amended by inserting, next after Regulation 21B, the following regulation:—
- "21c. Any member who at any time prior to the coming into force of the Government Railways Classification and Pay Regulations 1942, Amendment No. 4, had been promoted to Subgrade 7 of Grade 6 under the powers conferred on the General Manager by Regulation 21A may, provided his work and conduct have, in the opinion of the General Manager, been satisfactory, be examined as to his suitability for the performance of the duties of positions graded in Grade 5 in the Branch of the Department in which he is employed, and if he satisfies the examiner such member may be promoted to a position graded in Grade 5 either forthwith or, in the discretion of the General Manager, at some later date:

"Provided that such member shall not be promoted to a position in any grade higher than Grade 5 until he passes the examination specified in Regulation 20."
