THE RIGHT HON. P. FRASER PRESIDING IN COUNCIL

PURSUANT to the Government Railways Act, 1926, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, doth hereby make the following regulations.

REGULATIONS

1. These regulations may be cited as the Government Railways Classification and Pay Regulations 1942, Amendment No. 6, and shall be read together with and deemed part of the Government Railways Classification and Pay Regulations 1942* (hereinafter referred to as the principal regulations).

2. (1) The First Schedule to the principal regulations, as substituted by the Government Railways Classification and Pay Regulations 1942, Amendment No. 4, is revoked, and the following substituted therefor :—
