**THE GENERAL RESERVE CLASSIFICATION ORDER 1940,  
AMENDMENT NO. 2.**

PURSUANT to Regulation 5 of the National Service Emergency Regulations 1940,\* the Minister of National Service doth hereby order as follows:—

1. This Order may be cited as the General Reserve Classification Order 1940, Amendment No. 2.

2. This Order shall be read together with and deemed part of the General Reserve Classification Order 1940 † (hereinafter referred to as the principal Order).

3. Clause 3 (1) of the principal Order, as amended by the General Reserve Classification Order 1940, Amendment No. 1,‡ is hereby further amended by adding the following paragraph:—

“(f) Men who have been declared by a Medical Board to be permanently medically unfit for service with the armed forces.”

4. Clause 3 (2) of the principal Order, as amended as aforesaid, is hereby further amended by omitting “and (e)”, and substituting “(e), and (f)”.
