**THE GENERAL RESERVE CLASSIFICATION ORDER 1940,
AMENDMENT NO. 3.**

PURSUANT to Regulation 5 of the National Service Emergency Regulations 1940,* the Minister of National Service doth hereby order as follows:—

1. This Order may be cited as the General Reserve Classification Order 1940, Amendment No. 3.

2. This Order shall be read together with and deemed part of the General Reserve Classification Order 1940† (hereinafter referred to as the principal Order).

3. Clause 4 of the principal Order is hereby amended by revoking paragraph (b), and substituting the following paragraphs:—

“(b) Class B1 shall comprise all reservists of the First Division who for the time being have not attained the age of twenty years:

“(bb) Class B2 shall comprise all reservists of the First Division who for the time being have attained the age of twenty years but have not attained the age of twenty-one years.”
