THE GOVERNMENT RAILWAYS INDUSTRIAL TRIBUNAL (FEES AND TRAVELLING-ALLOWANCES) REGULATIONS 1946

Present :

HIS EXCELLENCY THE GOVERNOR-GENERAL IN COUNCIL

PURSUANT to sections 21 and 23 of the Government Railways Amendment Act, 1944, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, doth hereby make the following regulations.

REGULATIONS

1. These regulations may be cited as the Government Railways Industrial Tribunal (Fees and Travelling-allowances) Regulations 1946.

2. (1) For any time in which a member is in attendance at a sitting of the Tribunal the remuneration by way of salary, fees, or allowances, payable to such member shall be—

(a) For each day, a sum of £3 3s. :

(b) For each half-day, a sum of £1 11s. 6d.

(2) For any time in respect of which the Chairman of the Tribunal certifies that he or any other member is otherwise engaged in work in connection with matters under consideration by the Tribunal, the Minister of Finance may approve the payment of remuneration by way of salary, fees, or allowances to such member after the rates set out in paragraphs (a) and (b) of clause (1) of this regulation.

3. When the attendance of a member at a sitting of the Tribunal or in performing work in connection with matters under consideration by the Tribunal requires a member to absent himself from his usual place of residence for a continuous period of twenty-four hours or longer, or a period involving his leaving and returning on successive days, there shall be paid to him by way of travelling-allowance in respect of every day or part of a day on which he is so absent a sum of $\pounds 1$ 5s.

4. For the purposes of the last preceding regulation a day means a period of twenty-four hours commencing at midnight, and every period of absence shall be computed from and to the times of departure from and return to the member's usual place of residence.
