**ORDER IN COUNCIL**

At the Government Buildings at Wellington this 24th day of July 1962

Present:

THE RIGHT HON. KEITH HOLYOAKE PRESIDING IN COUNCIL

PURSUANT to the Government Railways Act 1949, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, hereby makes the following regulations.

**REGULATIONS**

**1.** These regulations may be cited as the Government Railways (Staff) Regulations 1953, Amendment No. 16, and shall be read together with and deemed part of the Government Railways (Staff) Regulations 1953\* (hereinafter referred to as the principal regulations).

**2.** (1) The principal regulations are hereby amended by revoking the First Schedule (as substituted by regulation 6 of the Government Railways (Staff) Regulations 1953, Amendment No. 15) and substituting the First Schedule set out in the Schedule to these regulations.

(2) This regulation shall come into force on the day after the date of its notification in the *Gazette*:

Provided that the First Schedule substituted by this regulation, so far as it relates to classes 7 and 8, shall be deemed to have come into force on the 1st day of April 1961.

## EXPLANATORY NOTE

*This note is not part of the regulations, but is intended to indicate their general effect.*

These regulations add pay assistants to the category of positions which can be filled by women employees, and also provide for an additional subgrade in Grade 2 of Class 7 and a new grading structure for Class 8.

Issued under the authority of the Regulations Act 1936.

Date of notification in *Gazette*: 26 July 1962.

These regulations are administered in the New Zealand Government Railways Department.
