**THE GOVERNMENT RAILWAYS (STAFF) REGULATIONS
1953, AMENDMENT NO. 17**

ORDER IN COUNCIL

At the Government House at Wellington this 3rd day of October 1962

Present:

HIS EXCELLENCY THE ADMINISTRATOR OF THE GOVERNMENT IN COUNCIL

PURSUANT to the Government Railways Act 1949, His Excellency the Administrator of the Government, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, hereby makes the following regulations.

REGULATIONS

1. These regulations may be cited as the Government Railways (Staff) Regulations 1953, Amendment No. 17, and shall be read together with and deemed part of the Government Railways (Staff) Regulations 1953* (hereinafter referred to as the principal regulations).

2. Regulation 2 of the principal regulations is hereby amended by repealing the definition of the term "leave year" and substituting the following:

" 'Leave year' means a period of 12 months commencing with the 1st day of December and ending with the 30th day of November:."

3. (1) The principal regulations are hereby amended by revoking the First Schedule (as substituted by regulation 2 of the Government Railways (Staff) Regulations 1953, Amendment No. 16), and substituting the First Schedule set out in the Schedule to these regulations.
