



THE GAME SEASON EMERGENCY REGULATIONS 1942

ORDER IN COUNCIL.

At the Government Buildings at Wellington, this 22nd day of April, 1942.

Present :

THE RIGHT HON. P. FRASER PRESIDING IN COUNCIL.

PURSUANT to the Emergency Regulations Act, 1939, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, doth hereby make the following regulations.

REGULATIONS.

1. These regulations may be cited as the Game Season Emergency Regulations 1942.

2. The notification made under the Animals Protection and Game Act, 1921-22, on the 27th day of March, 1942, and published in the *Gazette* on the same day at page 932, declaring open seasons for certain game shall have no force or effect.

3. No license to take or kill game, whether imported or native, issued pursuant to authority contained in the said notification, and no instrument of appointment issued pursuant to subsection (3) of section 14 of the Animals Protection and Game Act, 1921-22, and relating to the year 1942 shall have any force or effect.

4. The secretary of every acclimatization society, on production and surrender to him of any license issued under the authority of the notification referred to in Regulation 2 hereof and purporting to authorize the holder thereof to take or kill imported and/or native game in the acclimatization district controlled by that society during a period provided for by the said notification, and on being satisfied on such evidence as he sees fit to require that the person presenting the license is the person in whose name the license is issued, shall refund to that person the full amount of the fee acknowledged in the license as having been paid by the holder prior to the issue of the license.
