



THE GOVERNMENT SERVICE (DEFAULTERS) EMERGENCY REGULATIONS 1943

ORDER IN COUNCIL

At the Government Buildings at Wellington, this 28th day of April, 1943

Present :

THE RIGHT HON. P. FRASER PRESIDING IN COUNCIL

PURSUANT to the Emergency Regulations Act, 1939, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, doth hereby make the following regulations.

REGULATIONS

1. These regulations may be cited as the Government Service (Defaulters) Emergency Regulations 1943.

APPLICATION OF THESE REGULATIONS

2. These regulations apply with respect to all persons for the time being employed, whether permanently or temporarily, in any branch or department of the Government Service.

DEFAULTERS EMPLOYED IN GOVERNMENT SERVICE MAY BE DISMISSED

3. (1) Notwithstanding anything to the contrary in any Act or in any regulations under any Act, if any person with respect to whom these regulations apply has heretofore been or is hereafter convicted of any of the offences referred to in subclause (1) of Regulation 44A of the National Service Emergency Regulations 1940,* he may be summarily dismissed by the person or authority having for the time being the power to make appointments to the position or to positions of the same kind, or he may be dismissed by that person or authority on a shorter period of notice than the notice (if any) that would be required to be given if he were being dismissed on any other ground.

(2) No person who is dismissed pursuant to this clause shall have any right of appeal against his dismissal or shall have any claim for compensation or damages in respect of his dismissal.
