

# THE GOVERNMENT SUPERANNUATION FUND (COST-OF-LIVING ALLOWANCE) ORDER 1984

#### ORDER IN COUNCIL

At the Government Buildings at Wellington this 27th day of March 1984

#### Present:

THE RIGHT HON. D. MACINTYRE PRESIDING IN COUNCIL PURSUANT to section 56 of the Government Superannuation Fund Act 1956, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, hereby makes the following order.

# **ORDER**

- 1. Title and commencement—(1) This order may be cited as the Government Superannuation Fund (Cost-of-Living Allowance) Order 1984. (2) This order shall come into force on the 1st day of April 1984.
- 2. Allowance deemed to be salary—It is hereby declared that the cost-of-living allowance payable under the Economic Stabilisation (Cost-of-Living Allowance) Regulations 1984\* to any contributor under the Government Superannuation Fund Act 1956 shall be deemed to be salary for the purposes of Part II of that Act.

## **EXPLANATORY NOTE**

This note is not part of the order, but is intended to indicate its general effect.

This order, which comes into force on 1 April 1984, declares that the cost of living allowance payable under the Economic Stabilisation (Cost of Living Allowance) Regulations 1984 to any contributor under the Government Superannuation Fund Act 1956 shall be deemed to be salary for the purposes of Part II of that Act. By virtue of section 63 (1) of the Government Superannuation Fund Act 1963 the order applies to the allowance payable to any contributor who is a member of the Armed Forces, and by virtue of section 26 of the Government Superannuation Fund Amendment Act 1962 it will also apply to the allowance payable to any contributor who is a member of the Police or the Prisons Service.
