PURSUANT to the Government Service Tribunal Act 1948, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, hereby makes the following regulations.

REGULATIONS

1. These regulations may be cited as the Government Service Tribunal Regulations 1955, Amendment No. 3, and shall be read together with and deemed part of the Government Service Tribunal Regulations 1955* (hereinafter referred to as the principal regulations).

2. Regulation 4 of the principal regulations is hereby amended by omitting the expression "Subdivision 2", and substituting the expression "Subdivision 7".

EXPLANATORY NOTE

This note is not part of the regulations, but is intended to indicate their general effect.

These regulations extend the jurisdiction of the Government Service Tribunal by varying the definition of the term "employee" so as to make that term extend to officers who are not beyond Subdivision 7 of Class Special.
