PURSUANT to the Transport Act 1962, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, hereby makes the following regulations.

—
REGULATIONS

1. Title and commencement—(1) These regulations may be cited as the Goods Service Vehicle (Constructional) Regulations 1936, Amendment No. 3, and shall be read together with and deemed part of the Goods Service Vehicle (Constructional) Regulations 1936* (hereinafter referred to as the principal regulations).

(2) These regulations shall come into force on the 1st day of February 1971.

2. Offences and penalties—Regulation 11 of the principal regulations is hereby amended by revoking subclause (4) and substituting the following subclause:

“(4) Every person who commits an offence against these regulations is liable to the penalties specified in subsection (4) of section 30 of the Transport Act 1962.”

EXPLANATORY NOTE

This note is not part of the regulations, but is intended to indicate their general effect.

These regulations revoke the penalty provisions of the principal regulations. The general penalties for breaches of all regulations made under the Transport Act 1962 are now provided in section 30 (4) of that Act (as enacted by section 2 of the Transport Amendment Act 1970).
