

THE HARBOURS ACT AMENDMENT ORDER 1962

Pursuant to the Harbours Act 1950, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, hereby makes the following order.

ORDER

- 1. This order may be cited as the Harbours Act Amendment Order
- 2. The First Schedule to the Harbours Act 1950 (as substituted by section 20 (1) of the Harbours Amendment Act 1959) is hereby amended—
 - (a) By repealing so much thereof as relates to the Hokitika Harbour
 - (b) By repealing so much thereof as relates to the Tolaga Bay Harbour Board.
- 3. The Second Schedule to the Harbours Act 1950 is hereby amended by omitting the words "Awanui Harbour Board".

EXPLANATORY NOTE

This note is not part of the order, but is intended to indicate its general effect. Clause 2 amends the First Schedule to the Harbours Act 1950 (setting out the constitution of Harbour Boards) by omitting references to the Hokitika and Tolaga Bay Harbour Boards, which have been abolished.

Clause 3 amends the Second Schedule to that Act (specifying the Harbour Boards whose members comprise the members of a local authority) by omitting the Awanui Harbour Board, which has been abolished.
