PURSUANT to section 32 of the Health and Disability Services Act 1993, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, makes the following order.

ORDER

**1. Title and commencement**—(1) This order may be cited as the Health and Disability Services (Health Funding Authority) Order 1997.

(2) This order comes into force on 1 January 1998.

**2. Name of Transitional Health Authority changed to Health Funding Authority**—After the commencement of this order, the regional health authority established by the Health and Disability Services (Establishment of Transitional Health Authority) Order 1997\* and

previously called the Transitional Health Authority is to be called the Health Funding Authority.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

*This note is not part of the order, but is intended to indicate its general effect.*

This order, which comes into force on 1 January 1998, changes the name of the Transitional Health Authority (a regional health authority) to the Health Funding Authority.
