THE HEARING AIDS NOTICE 1955, AMENDMENT NO. 2

PURSUANT to regulation 4 of the Social Security (Hospital Benefits for Outpatients) Regulations 1947, the Minister of Health hereby gives the following notice.

NOTICE

1. This notice may be cited as the Hearing Aids Notice 1955, Amendment No. 2, and shall be read together with and deemed part of the Hearing Aids Notice 1955* (hereinafter referred to as the principal notice).

2. The Schedule to the principal notice, as amended by the Hearing Aids Notice 1955, Amendment No. 1, is hereby further amended by inserting, after the words "Audium hearing aids", the words "Audivox hearing aids".

The effect of this notice is that Audivox hearing aids become an approved type of electrical hearing aid for hospital outpatients under the Hearing Aids Notice 1955.
