THE HEARING AIDS NOTICE 1957, AMENDMENT NO. 1

PURSUANT to regulation 4 of the Social Security (Hospital Benefits for Outpatients) Regulations 1947, the Minister of Health hereby gives the following notice.

NOTICE

1. This notice may be cited as the Hearing Aids Notice 1957, Amendment No. 1, and shall be read together with and deemed part of the Hearing Aids Notice 1957* (hereinafter referred to as the principal notice).

2. The Schedule to the principal notice is hereby amended as follows:

- (a) By inserting, after the words "Multitone hearing aids", the words "Omikron hearing aids":
- (b) By inserting, after the words "Supertone hearing aids", the words "Telex hearing aids.
"Vienna hearing aids.
"Wendton hearing aids.":
- (c) By inserting, after the words "Western Electric hearing aids", the words "Willco hearing aids".

EXPLANATORY NOTE

This note is not part of the notice, but is intended to indicate its general effect.

The effect of this notice is that Omikron, Telex, Vienna, Wendton, and Willco hearing aids become approved types of electrical hearing aids for hospital outpatients under the Hearing Aids Notice 1957.
