PURSUANT to section 117 (4) (a) of the Hospitals Act 1957, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, hereby makes the following order.

ORDER

1. This order may be cited as the Hospitals Act (Separate Institutions) Amendment Order 1968.
2. The Second Schedule to the Hospitals Act 1957 is hereby amended by omitting the name "The Hawke's Bay Children's Home".

EXPLANATORY NOTE

This note is not part of the order, but is intended to indicate its general effect.

Under section 117 of the Hospitals Act 1957, that Act ceases to apply to a separate institution under Part IV if its corporation becomes registered as an incorporated society under the Incorporated Societies Act 1908. The Hawke's Bay Children's Home became so registered on 15 March 1967.

This order accordingly removes the name of the Hawke's Bay Children's Home from the Second Schedule to the Hospitals Act 1957.
