PURSUANT to sections 21 (1)(b) and 59 of the Health and Safety in Employment Act 1992, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, makes the following regulations.

REGULATIONS

1. Title and commencement—(1) These regulations may be cited as the Health and Safety in Employment (Rates of Funding Levy) Amendment Regulations 1999, and are part of the Health and Safety in Employment (Rates of Funding Levy) Regulations 1994* (“the principal regulations”).

(2) These regulations come into force on 1 April 1999.

2. Rate of funding levy payable by employers—Regulation 2 of the principal regulations is amended by omitting the expression “6 cents”, and substituting the expression “5 cents”.

3. Rate of funding levy payable by certain earners—Regulation 3 of the principal regulations is amended by omitting the expression “6 cents”, and substituting the expression “5 cents”.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

This note is not part of the regulations, but is intended to indicate their general effect.

These regulations, which come into force on 1 April 1999, decrease from 6 cents per \$100 to 5 cents per \$100 the rates of the funding levy payable by employers and the self-employed to meet the costs of the administration of the Health and Safety in Employment Act 1992.
