**THE HOSPITAL BOARD EMPLOYEES (CONDITIONS OF EMPLOYMENT) REGULATIONS 1959, AMENDMENT NO. 2**

**ORDER IN COUNCIL**

At the Government House at Wellington this 15th day of December 1975

Present:

HIS EXCELLENCY THE GOVERNOR-GENERAL IN COUNCIL

PURSUANT to the Hospitals Act 1957, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, hereby makes the following regulations.

**REGULATIONS**

**1. Title and commencement**—(1) These regulations may be cited as the Hospital Board Employees (Conditions of Employment) Regulations 1959, Amendment No. 2, and shall be read together with and deemed part of the Hospital Board Employees (Conditions of Employment) Regulations 1959\* (hereinafter referred to as the principal regulations).

(2) These regulations shall come into force on the day after the date of their notification in the *Gazette*.

**2. Membership of advisory committees**—(1) Regulation 4 (1) (b) of the principal regulations is hereby amended by omitting the words “(being not more than five)”, and substituting the words “(being not less than 3 nor more than 6)”.

(2) Regulation 4 (1) of the principal regulations is hereby further amended by revoking paragraph (c), and substituting the following paragraph:

“(c) An equal number of other persons, 2 of whom are members of Hospital Boards, 1 of whom is the Secretary of a Hospital Board appointed after consultation with the Hospital Boards’ Association of New Zealand Incorporated, and the remainder of whom (if any) are officers of the Public Service.”

(3) Regulation 2 (b) of the Hospital Board Employees (Conditions of Employment) Regulations 1959, Amendment No. 1, is hereby consequentially revoked.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

*This note is not part of the regulations, but is intended to indicate their general effect.*

These regulations increase the maximum number of members of an advisory committee by 2.

Regulation 2 (1) increases the maximum number of hospital board employees which may be appointed to an advisory committee from 5 to 6. A minimum number of 3 is also provided for.

Regulation 2 (2) provides for the appointment to every advisory committee of a Secretary of a Hospital Board who is to be appointed after consultation with the Hospital Boards' Association.
