THE HONEY BOARD (TRANSFER OF POWERS) ORDER 1938.

ORDER IN COUNCIL.

At the Government House at Wellington, this 9th day of November, 1938.

Present :

HIS EXCELLENCY THE GOVERNOR-GENERAL IN COUNCIL.

PURSUANT to section 7 of the Agriculture (Emergency Powers) Act, 1934, as modified by subsection (2) of section 8 of the Primary Products Marketing Act, 1936, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, doth hereby make the following Order.

ORDER.

1. This Order may be cited as the Honey Board (Transfer of Powers) Order 1938.
2. This Order shall come into force on the day following notification in the *Gazette* of the making thereof.
3. In this Order—
 - “ Board ” means the New Zealand Honey Control Board established by the Honey Export Control Act, 1924 ;
 - “ Minister ” means the Minister of Marketing.
4. The powers heretofore conferred on or vested in the Board by the Honey Export Control Act, 1924, or by any other Act or otherwise howsoever, are hereby transferred to the Minister, and accordingly all references to the Board in any enactment or other instrument of authority by which powers are conferred on the Board shall, where necessary as from the coming into force of this Order, be read as references to the Minister.
5. The Minister accordingly may, as from the date of the coming into force of this Order, exercise the powers transferred as aforesaid and may delegate any such powers as authorized by the Primary Products Marketing Act, 1936, and subsection (2) of section 7 of the Agriculture (Emergency Powers) Act, 1934.
