**THE HARBOUR BOARDS (TRAVELLING-ALLOWANCE)
REGULATIONS 1950**

ORDER IN COUNCIL

THE HON. S. G. HOLLAND PRESIDING IN COUNCIL

PURSUANT to the Harbours Act, 1923, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, doth hereby make the following regulations.

REGULATIONS

1. These regulations may be cited as the Harbour Boards (Travelling-allowance) Regulations 1950.

2. The Harbour Boards (Travelling-allowance) Regulations 1945* are hereby revoked.

3. These regulations shall come into force on the seventh day after the notification in the *Gazette* of the making thereof.

4. (1) The Travelling-allowance Regulations 1949† shall apply to and be deemed to be incorporated in these regulations so as to relate to Harbour Boards within the meaning of the Harbours Act, 1923, and members thereof.

(2) The subsistence allowance referred to in Regulation 5 of the Travelling-allowance Regulations 1949 shall be at the rate of £1 15s. a day :

Provided that where a member is entitled to a subsistence allowance and occupies a hotel room for one night only, an additional amount of 2s. may be paid to that member.

(3) The mileage allowance referred to in Regulation 13 of the Travelling-allowance Regulations 1949 shall be calculated in accordance with the following table :—

Horse-power of Car.	Mileage Allowance.
Not exceeding 9½	5½d. a mile.
Exceeding 9½ but not exceeding 14½	6½d. a mile.
Over 14½	7d. a mile.

(4) Garage expenses payable to a member pursuant to this regulation shall not exceed 2s. 6d. for every night on which any such expenses are incurred.

5. Any Harbour Board may, with the sanction of the Audit Office, pay to any member of the Board, in lieu of the payments authorized by the foregoing regulations, a sum not exceeding the necessary expenses actually incurred and paid by that member.
