ORDER IN COUNCIL

At the Government House at Wellington this 2nd day of August 1983

HIS EXCELLENCY THE GOVERNOR-GENERAL IN COUNCIL

PURSUANT to sections 26 and 27 of the Hospitals Act 1957, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, hereby makes the following order.

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ORDER

1. Title and commencement—(1) This order may be cited as the Hospital Boards Representation Order 1983.

(2) This order shall come into force on the 14th day after the date of its notification in the *Gazette*.

2. Combined districts—Where the names of 2 or more constituent districts within a Hospital District are shown bracketed together in the second column of the Schedule to this order, those constituent districts are hereby combined into a combined district for the purpose of the election of representatives on the Board of that Hospital District.

3. Principal local authorities—Where 2 or more constituent districts are combined into a combined district under clause 2 of this order, the Council of that one of them after whose name in the second column of

the Schedule to this order the expression "(P)" is placed is hereby selected and appointed to be the principal local authority of that combined district for the purpose of the conduct of elections within that district.

4. Representation of constituent districts—At the triennial election of members of Boards next held after the commencement of this order, and at all such elections thereafter, there shall be elected to every Board whose District is specified in the first column of the Schedule to this order, as representatives of every constituent district or combined district specified in the second column of that Schedule opposite the reference to that Board's District, the number of persons specified in the third column of that Schedule opposite the reference to that constituent district or combined district.

5. Revocation—The Hospital Boards (Representation of Constituent Districts) Order 1980* is hereby consequentially revoked.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

This note is not part of the order, but is intended to indicate its general effect.

This order replaces, with amendments, the existing order fixing representation on Hospital Boards, defining combined districts, and appointing a principal local authority to conduct elections for each combined district.

The amendments affect 3 Hospital Boards. The membership of the Marlborough Hospital Board is reduced from 12 to 9 by reducing the representation of the Marlborough County Council from 5 to 4 members and that of the Blenheim Borough Council from 6 to 4 members. The membership of the Vincent Hospital Board is reduced from 11 to 10 by reducing the representation of the Vincent County Council from 5 to 4 members. The membership of the Waipawa Hospital Board is reduced from 11 to 8 by reducing the representation of the Waipawa District Council from 4 to 3 members and that of the Waipukurau District Council from 7 to 5 members.

The amendments will not take effect until the next Hospital Board elections.
