ORDER IN COUNCIL

At Wellington this 7th day of July 1986

HIS EXCELLENCY THE GOVERNOR-GENERAL IN COUNCIL

PURSUANT to sections 26, 27, and 29 (2c) of the Hospitals Act 1957, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, hereby makes the following order.

ORDER

1. Title and commencement—(1) This order may be cited as the Hospital Boards Representation Order 1986.

(2) This order shall come into force on the 8th day of July 1986.

2. Combined districts—Where the names of 2 or more constituent districts within a Hospital District are shown bracketed together in the second column of the Schedule to this order, those constituent districts are combined into a combined district for the purpose of the election of representatives on the Board of the Hospital District.

3. Principal local authorities—Where 2 or more constituent districts are combined into a combined district under clause 2 of this order, the Council of that one of them after whose name in the second column of the Schedule the expression “(P)” is placed is selected and appointed to be the principal local authority of the combined district for the purpose of the conduct of elections within the combined district.

4. Representation of constituent districts—At the triennial election of members of Boards next held after the commencement of this order, and at all such elections thereafter, there shall be elected to every Board whose Hospital District is specified in the first column of the Schedule, as representatives of every constituent district or combined district specified in the second column of the Schedule opposite the reference to the Hospital District, the number of persons specified in the fourth column of the Schedule opposite the reference to the constituent district or combined district.

5. Some elections to be held on basis of wards—Where any wards are specified in the third column of the Schedule opposite the reference in the second column of the Schedule to any constituent district of the Hospital District of any Board, it is directed that the election of representatives on the Board shall be by the electors of each ward of the constituent district.

6. Combined wards—Where the names of 2 or more wards within a constituent district are shown bracketed together in the third column of the Schedule, those wards are hereby combined into a combined ward for the purpose of the election of representatives on the Board of the Hospital District specified in the first column of the Schedule opposite the reference to the wards.

7. Representation of wards—There shall be elected to every Board opposite the reference to whose Hospital District in the first column of the Schedule wards or combined wards are specified in the third column of the Schedule, as representatives of every ward or combined ward, the number of persons specified in the fourth column of the Schedule opposite the reference to the ward or combined ward.

8. Revocations—The Hospital Boards Representation Order 1983* and the Hospital Boards Representation Order 1983, Amendment No. 1† are hereby consequentially revoked.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

This note is not part of the order, but is intended to indicate its general effect.

This order replaces, with amendments, the existing order fixing representation on Hospital Boards, defining combined districts, and appointing a principal local authority to conduct elections for each combined district. It also provides that representatives of the Thames-Coromandel District on the Thames Hospital Board, and all representatives on the Central Hawke's Bay Hospital Board, are to be elected on the basis of wards and combined wards, and fixes ward representation and defines combined wards.

The new arrangements will not take effect until the next Hospital Board elections.
