ORDER IN COUNCIL

At the Government House at Wellington this 25th day of June 1958

Present:

HIS EXCELLENCY THE GOVERNOR-GENERAL IN COUNCIL

PURSUANT to the Harbours Act 1950, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, hereby makes the following order.

ORDER

1. This order may be cited as the Harbour Boards Representation Order 1958.

2. (1) The First Schedule to the Harbours Act 1950 is hereby amended by omitting from that part of the Schedule that relates to the Auckland Harbour Board the words "and of the Town District of Leamington".

(2) The Order in Council made on the 18th day of October 1950 appointing principal authorities for the election of members of Harbour Boards* is hereby amended by omitting from that part of the Schedule that relates to the Auckland Harbour Board the words "and the Town District of Leamington".

EXPLANATORY NOTE

This note is not part of the order, but is intended to indicate its general effect.

This order alters the existing provisions relating to the election of certain members of the Auckland Harbour Board and the appointment of the principal authority for the purpose of the election in one of the combined districts of that Board. The alterations are consequential on the inclusion of the Town District of Leamington in the Borough of Cambridge.
