



## THE HEALTH DISTRICTS NOTICE 1988, AMENDMENT NO. 1

PURSUANT to section 19 (1) of the Health Act 1956 (as substituted by section 5 (1) of the Health Amendment Act 1988), the Director-General of Health hereby gives the following notice.

### NOTICE

**1. Title and commencement**—(1) This notice may be cited as the Health Districts Notice 1988, Amendment No. 1, and shall be read together with and deemed part of the Health Districts Notice 1988\* (hereinafter referred to as the principal notice).

(2) This notice shall come into force on the 1st day of December 1988.

**2. Schedule amended**—The Schedule to the principal notice is hereby amended—

- (a) By omitting the item relating to the Takapuna Health District;
- (b) By omitting the item relating to the Auckland Health District;
- (c) By omitting the item relating to the South Auckland Health District.

### EXPLANATORY NOTE

*This note is not part of the notice, but is intended to indicate its general effect.*

This notice, which comes into force on 1 December 1988, is consequential upon the establishment of the Auckland Area Health District and abolishes the Takapuna Health District, the Auckland Health District, and the South Auckland Health District.
