

THE HEALTH DISTRICTS NOTICE 1988, AMENDMENT NO. 1

- 1. Title and commencement—(1) This notice may be cited as the Health Districts Notice 1988, Amendment No. 1, and shall be read together with and deemed part of the Health Districts Notice 1988* (hereinafter referred to as the principal notice).
 - (2) This notice shall come into force on the 1st day of December 1988.
- **2. Schedule amended**—The Schedule to the principal notice is hereby amended—
 - (a) By omitting the item relating to the Takapuna Health District:

 - (c) By omitting the item relating to the South Auckland Health District.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

This note is not part of the notice, but is intended to indicate its general effect.

This notice, which comes into force on 1 December 1988, is consequential upon the establishment of the Auckland Area Health District and abolishes the Takapuna Health District, the Auckland Health District, and the South Auckland Health District.
