ORDER IN COUNCIL

At the Government Buildings at Wellington this 19th day of December 1961

PURSUANT to the Health Act 1956, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, hereby makes the following order.

ORDER

1. (1) This order may be cited as the Health Districts Order 1960, Amendment No. 1, and shall be read together with and deemed part of the Health Districts Order 1960* (hereinafter referred to as the principal order).

(2) This order shall come into force on the 1st day of January 1962.

2. The Schedule to the principal order is hereby amended by omitting the words "Manukau-Franklin Health District", being the name of the fourth district described, and substituting the words "South Auckland Health District".

EXPLANATORY NOTE

This note is not part of the order, but is intended to indicate its general effect.

This order provides that the Health District heretofore known as the Manukau-Franklin Health District shall in future be known as the South Auckland Health District.
