ORDER IN COUNCIL

At the Government House at Wellington this 26th day of August 1985

Present:

HIS EXCELLENCY THE GOVERNOR-GENERAL IN COUNCIL

PURSUANT to section 19 of the Health Act 1956, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, hereby makes the following order.

ORDER

1. Title and commencement—(1) This order may be cited as the Health Districts Order 1982, Amendment No. 1, and shall be read together with and deemed part of the Health Districts Order 1982* (hereinafter referred to as the principal order).

(2) This order shall come into force on the 1st day of September 1985.

2. Defining Health Districts—The principal order is hereby amended by revoking clause 2, and substituting the following clause:

“2. (1) For the purposes of the Health Act 1956, New Zealand (except any part that is included in any area health district established pursuant to the Area Health Boards Act 1983) is hereby divided into the Health Districts named and described in the Schedule to this notice.

“(2) Each such Health District shall be deemed to include all islands adjacent to the district as so described.”

3. Schedule amended—The Schedule to the principal order is hereby amended by revoking so much as relates to the Whangarei Health District.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

This note is not part of the order, but is intended to indicate its general effect.

This order abolishes the Whangarei Health District consequent upon the establishment of the Northland Area Health District.
