THE HOSPITAL EMPLOYMENT (SECRETARIAL AND CLERICAL OFFICERS) REGULATIONS 1957, AMENDMENT NO. 1

HIS EXCELLENCY THE GOVERNOR-GENERAL IN COUNCIL

Pursuant to the Hospitals Act 1926, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, hereby makes the following regulations.

REGULATIONS

- 1. (1) These regulations may be cited as the Hospital Employment (Secretarial and Clerical Officers) Regulations 1957, Amendment No. 1, and shall be read together with and deemed part of the Hospital Employment (Secretarial and Clerical Officers) Regulations 1957* (hereinafter referred to as the special regulations).
- (2) These regulations shall be deemed to have come into force on the 19th day of November 1956.
- 2. The special regulations are hereby amended by revoking regulation 4, and substituting the following regulation:
 - "Scales of Salaries for Whole Time Secretarial or Clerical Officers
- "4. Subject to the provisions of regulations 5 to 8 hereof, a whole time secretarial or clerical officer shall receive a yearly rate of salary according to the scale of salary from time to time determined in each case by the Grading Committee, with the approval of the Minister, that scale being one of the thirteen following:

- 3. Regulation 10 of the special regulations is hereby amended as follows:
 - (a) By omitting from paragraph (a) of subclause (1), and also from paragraphs (b) and (c) of the same subclause, the expression "14s. 9d.", and substituting in each case the expression "16s. 0d.":
 - (b) By omitting from the first proviso to subclause (1) the expression "£1,110", and substituting the expression "£1,150".

EXPLANATORY NOTE

This note is not part of the regulations, but is intended to indicate their general effect.

These regulations prescribe new scales of saiaries for secretarial and clerical officers employed by Hospital Boards.
