Pursuant to the Hospitals Act 1957, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, hereby makes the following regulations.

REGULATIONS

- 1. Title and commencement—(1) These regulations may be cited as the Hospital Employment (Grading Committees) Regulations 1973, Amendment No. 1, and shall be read together with and deemed part of the Hospital Employment (Grading Committees) Regulations 1973* (hereinafter referred to as the principal regulations).
- (2) These regulations shall come into force on the day after the date of their notification in the Gazette.
- 2. Engineers' Salaries Grading Committee—Regulation 6 (d) of the principal regulations is hereby amended by omitting the word "Public".
- 3. Medical Officers' Salaries Grading Committee—Regulation 8 (d) of the principal regulations is hereby amended by omitting the words "Medical Association of New Zealand", and substituting the words "New Zealand Medical Association".

- 4. Radiographers' Salaries Grading Committee—Regulation 9 (d) of the principal regulations is hereby amended by omitting the words ", not being X-ray workers employed by Hospital Boards,".
- 5. Medical Officers' Salaries Grading Committee—Regulation 12 (1) of the principal regulations is hereby amended by—

(a) Omitting from paragraph (a) the words "a specialist or tutor specialist", and substituting the words "a specialist, tutor specialist, or medical officer of special scale".

- (b) Omitting from paragraph (d) the words "within the basic specialist scale in exceptional circumstances", and substituting the words "in exceptional circumstances within the basic specialist scale or within the scales for medical officers of special scale".
- 6. Absence of chairman—Regulation 14 (1) of the principal regulations is hereby amended by omitting the words "the person appointed under subclause (2) of regulation 15 of these regulations to attend the meeting in his stead shall be chairman of the meeting", and substituting the words "the chairman shall nominate either the person appointed under regulation 15 (2) of these regulations or a member of the committee to be chairman of the meeting".
- 7. Determinations of Grading Committees—Regulation 16 of the principal regulations is hereby amended by adding the following subclause:
- "(5) Upon making a determination for the purposes of these regulations, the grading committee shall notify the employee's employing Board of the determination and that Board shall within 14 days of the receipt of such notification, notify the employee of the determination."
- 8. Special provisions relating to graded employees other than medical officers—Regulation 18 of the principal regulations is hereby amended by omitting the words "graded laboratory officer, staff medical laboratory technologist, or graduate technologist", and substituting the words "graded employee other than a medical officer".

EXPLANATORY NOTE

This note is not part of the regulations, but is intended to indicate their general effect.

Regulations 2 and 3 correct names.

Regulation 4 allows X-ray workers employed by Hospital Boards to be members of the Radiographers' Salaries Grading Committee.

Regulation 5 provides for the Medical Officers' Salaries Grading Committee to review the salaries of Medical Officers of special scale.

Regulation 6 provides for the situation where a chairman has appointed another person to attend a meeting in his stead, but it is more appropriate for another member of the committee to chair the meeting.

Regulation 7 provides for employees to be notified of determinations.

Regulation 8 extends the right to apply for a review of salary to all graded employees other than medical officers.
