**THE HOSPITAL EMPLOYMENT (DENTAL OFFICERS)
REGULATIONS 1963, AMENDMENT NO. 3**

ORDER IN COUNCIL

At the Government House at Wellington this 5th day of July 1967

Present:

HIS EXCELLENCY THE GOVERNOR-GENERAL IN COUNCIL

PURSUANT to the Hospitals Act 1957, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, hereby makes the following regulations.

REGULATIONS

1. These regulations may be cited as the Hospital Employment (Dental Officers) Regulations 1963, Amendment No. 3, and shall be read together with and deemed part of the Hospital Employment (Dental Officers) Regulations 1963* (hereinafter referred to as the special regulations).

2. The scales of salaries specified in the Schedule to regulation 4 of the special regulations (as substituted by regulation 3 of these regulations) shall be deemed to have come into force on the dates respectively shown in the headings of the columns of that Schedule headed "Yearly Rate of Salary on and from 26 August 1964", "Yearly Rate of Salary on and from 1 August 1965", and "Yearly Rate of Salary on and from 1 April 1966".

3. (1) Regulation 4 of the special regulations is hereby amended by revoking the Schedule to that regulation (as substituted by regulation 3 of the Hospital Employment (Dental Officers) Regulations 1963, Amendment No. 2), and substituting the following Schedule:
