**THE HOSPITAL EMPLOYMENT (ENGINEERS) REGULATIONS
1963, AMENDMENT NO. 3**

ORDER IN COUNCIL

At the Government House at Wellington this 5th day of July 1967

Present:

HIS EXCELLENCY THE GOVERNOR-GENERAL IN COUNCIL

PURSUANT to the Hospitals Act 1957, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, hereby makes the following regulations.

REGULATIONS

1. These regulations may be cited as the Hospital Employment (Engineers) Regulations 1963, Amendment No. 3, and shall be read together with and deemed part of the Hospital Employment (Engineers) Regulations 1963* (hereinafter referred to as the special regulations).

2. (1) The scales of salaries specified in regulation 4 of the special regulations (as substituted by regulation 3 of these regulations) shall be deemed to have come into force on the dates respectively shown in the headings of the columns therein headed "Yearly Rate of Salary on and from 26 August 1964," "Yearly Rate of Salary on and from 1 August 1965", and "Yearly Rate of Salary on and from 1 April 1966".

(2) Regulations 4, 5, and 6 of these regulations shall be deemed to have come into force on the 26th day of August 1964.

3. Regulation 4 of the special regulations is hereby amended by revoking subclause (1) (as substituted by regulation 3 of the Hospital Employment (Engineers) Regulations 1963, Amendment No. 2), and substituting the following subclause:

"(1) Subject to the provisions of regulations 5 to 10 of these regulations, a whole-time engineer shall receive a yearly rate of salary according to the scale of salary from time to time determined in each case by the Grading Committee, with the approval of the Minister, that scale being one of the eight following:

4. The special regulations are hereby further amended by revoking regulation 5 (as substituted by regulation 4 of the Hospital Employment (Engineers) Regulations 1963, Amendment No. 2), and substituting the following regulation:

“5. Notwithstanding anything to the contrary in regulation 4 of these regulations, the Grading Committee may, with the approval of the Minister, determine in the case of an engineer who, in the opinion of the Grading Committee, is a person of exceptional qualifications and training or of exceptional experience a yearly rate of salary exceeding the maximum of £2,415 from 26 August 1964, £2,445 from 1 August 1965, and £2,505 from 1 April 1966 specified in subclause (1) of the said regulation 4, but in no case exceeding £2,555 from 26 August 1964, £2,575 from 1 August 1965, or £2,665 from 1 April 1966.”

5. Regulation 7 of the special regulations (as amended by regulation 5 of the Hospital Employment (Engineers) Regulations 1963, Amendment No. 2) is hereby further amended by omitting from subclause (3) the words “1st day of August 1963” wherever they occur, and substituting in each case the words “26th day of August 1964”.

6. Regulation 9 of the special regulations is hereby amended by revoking subclause (3) (as substituted by regulation 6 of the Hospital Employment (Engineers) Regulations 1963, Amendment No. 2), and substituting the following subclause:

“(3) This regulation shall apply to shift engineers whose yearly rate of salary does not exceed £1,395 on and from 26 August 1964 and £1,445 on and from 1 August 1965.”

7. Regulations 3, 4, 5, and 6 of the Hospital Employment (Engineers) Regulations 1963, Amendment No. 2, are hereby revoked.

This note is not part of the regulations, but is intended to indicate their general effect.

These regulations provide amended conditions of employment for engineers employed by Hospital Boards.
