THE HOSPITAL EMPLOYMENT (MALE NURSES) REGULATIONS 1952, AMENDMENT NO. 3

HIS EXCELLENCY THE GOVERNOR-GENERAL IN COUNCIL.

Pursuant to the Hospitals Act 1926, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, hereby makes the following regulations.

REGULATIONS

- 1. (1) These regulations may be cited as the Hospital Employment (Male Nurses) Regulations 1952, Amendment No. 3, and shall be read together with and deemed part of the Hospital Employment (Male Nurses) Regulations 1952* (hereinafter referred to as the special regulations).
- (2) These regulations shall be deemed to have come into force on the 1st day of January 1955.
- 2. (1) Regulation 4 of the special regulations is hereby amended by revoking clause 6 of the Schedule thereto (as substituted by regulation 3 of the Hospital Employment (Male Nurses) Regulations 1952, Amendment No. 1, and amended by regulation 2 of the Hospital Employment (Male Nurses) Regulations 1952, Amendment No. 2), and substituting the following clause:

S.R. 1952/91. Amendment No. 1: S.R. 1953/98. Amendment No. 2: S.R. 1954/108. (2) The remuneration provided for by subclause (1) of this regulation shall be subject to the general wage increase prescribed by regulation 3 (2) of the Hospital Employment Regulations 1952, Amendment No. 1 (as amended by regulation 3 of the Hospital Employment Regulations 1952, Amendment No. 2†).

(3) Regulation 2 of the Hospital Employment (Male Nurses) Regula-

tions 1952, Amendment No. 1, is hereby revoked.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

[This note is not part of the regulations, but is intended to indicate their general effect.]

These regulations prescribe a new rate of salary for pupil male nurses in the third year of training and thereafter, and delete reference to pupil male nurses in the first and second year of training as they are not now subject to Hospital Employment Regulations.

Issued under the authority of the Regulations Act 1936. Date of notification in *Gazette:* 4 August 1955. These regulations are administered in the Department of Health.
