THE HOSPITAL EMPLOYMENT (MEDICAL OFFICERS) REGULATIONS 1957, AMENDMENT NO. 2

HIS EXCELLENCY THE GOVERNOR-GENERAL IN COUNCIL

PURSUANT to the Hospitals Act 1957, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, hereby makes the following regulations.

REGULATIONS

1. (1) These regulations may be cited as the Hospital Employment (Medical Officers) Regulations 1957, Amendment No. 2, and shall be read together with and deemed part of the Hospital Employment (Medical Officers) Regulations 1957* (hereinafter referred to as the special regulations).

(2) Regulation 2 of these regulations shall be deemed to have come

into force on the 1st day of January 1958.

(3) Regulation 3 of these regulations shall come into force on the day

after the date of the notification of these regulations in the Gazette.

2. Regulation 7 of the special regulations is hereby amended by revoking paragraph (b) of clause 1 of the Schedule to that regulation (as substituted by regulation 2 of the Hospital Employment (Medical Officers) Regulations 1957, Amendment No. 1), and substituting the following paragraph:

"(b) Senior house surgeon 745 \$55 110"

3. Regulation 14 of the special regulations is hereby amended by adding to subclause (5), the words "but the provisions of regulations 17 and 18 of these regulations shall not apply in the case of visiting medical officers employed under this proviso".

EXPLANATORY NOTE

These regulations provide amended conditions of employment for medical officers employed by Hospital Boards.
