THE HON. K. J. HOLYOAKE PRESIDING IN COUNCIL

PURSUANT to the Economic Stabilization Act, 1948, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, doth hereby make the following regulations.

REGULATIONS

1. (1) These regulations may be cited as the Hides Emergency Regulations 1940 (No. 2), Amendment No. 2, and shall be read together with and deemed part of the Hides Emergency Regulations 1940 (No. 2)* (hereinafter referred to as the principal regulations).

(2) These regulations shall come into force on the day of their notification in the *Gazette*.

2. Regulation 3 of the principal regulations is hereby amended by revoking the definition of the term "Factory Controller".

3. Regulation 8 of the principal regulations is hereby amended by omitting from subclauses (4), (5), (8), and (9) the words "Factory Controller" wherever they occur, and substituting in each case the words "Secretary of Industries and Commerce".
