**THE HONEY EMERGENCY REGULATIONS 1944,
AMENDMENT NO. 1**

ORDER IN COUNCIL

At the Government House at Wellington, this 11th day of
July, 1945

Present :

HIS EXCELLENCY THE GOVERNOR-GENERAL IN COUNCIL

PURSUANT to the Emergency Regulations Act, 1939, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, doth hereby make the following regulations.

REGULATIONS

1. These regulations may be cited as the Honey Emergency Regulations 1944, Amendment No. 1, and shall be read together with and deemed part of the Honey Emergency Regulations 1944* (hereinafter referred to as the principal regulations).

2. The principal regulations are hereby amended by inserting, after Regulation 3, the following heading and regulation :—

“ EXEMPTIONS

“ 3A. (1) The Director may from time to time grant to any person or body of persons complete or partial exemption from compliance with the provisions of these regulations or any of them.

“ (2) Every person who applies to the Director for any exemption under these regulations shall furnish such information and particulars as the Director may from time to time require.

“ (3) The Director, in his discretion, may refuse any such application, or may grant the application wholly or partly, and either unconditionally or upon or subject to such conditions as he thinks fit.

“ (4) Any exemption may be at any time revoked by the Director, and any such conditions may from time to time be varied, revoked, or added to by the Director as he thinks fit.

“(5) In any proceedings for an offence against these regulations, a certificate in writing signed by the Director certifying that any person or body of persons has been granted any exemption under these regulations shall, in the absence of proof to the contrary, be sufficient evidence that the exemption has been granted.”

3. Regulation 8 of the principal regulations is hereby amended by inserting in paragraph (b), after the word “Department”, the words “or with any condition imposed under these regulations”.
