THE RIGHT HON. S. G. HOLLAND PRESIDING IN COUNCIL

PURSUANT to the Hospitals Act, 1926, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, doth hereby make the following regulations.

REGULATIONS

1. These regulations may be cited as the Hospital Employment Regulations 1948, Amendment No. 16, and shall be read together with and deemed part of the Hospital Employment Regulations 1948* (hereinafter referred to as the principal regulations).

2. (1) The scales of salaries specified in the Schedule to regulation 67 of the principal regulations (as substituted by regulation 4 hereof) shall be deemed to have come into force on the dates respectively shown in the headings of the columns therein headed "Yearly Rate of Salary from 1st April, 1949", and "Yearly Rate of Salary from 1st June, 1949".

(2) Such other of the provisions of these regulations as have the effect of increasing the rates of salaries, wages, and other emoluments and increments payable in respect of the classes of persons whose positions are specified in these regulations shall be deemed to have come into force on the 1st day of April, 1949.

(3) Except as provided in the last two preceding clauses, these regulations shall come into force on the day after the date of their notification in the *Gazette*.

3. Regulation 66 of the principal regulations (as set out in regulation 3 of the Hospital Employment Regulations 1948, Amendment No. 4) is hereby amended as follows:—

- (a) By revoking the definition of the term "established beds":
 (b) By omitting from the definition of the term "first assistant dietitian" the words "a dietitian", and substituting the words "the dietitian".

4. Regulation 67 of the principal regulations (as set out in regulation 3 of the Hospital Employment Regulations 1948, Amendment No. 4) is hereby amended by revoking the Schedule thereto, and substituting the following Schedule:—

6. Regulation 72 of the principal regulations (as set out in regulation 3 of the Hospital Employment Regulations 1948, Amendment No. 4) is hereby amended by inserting, after the word "behalf", the words "and subject to the prior approval of the Minister".

7. Regulation 73 of the principal regulations (as set out in regulation 3 of the Hospital Employment Regulations 1948, Amendment No. 4) is hereby amended by omitting from clause (1) the words " which, together with the basic annual salary as hereinafter defined, equals £460 ", and substituting the words " of £40 in any year ".
