



**THE HOSPITAL EMPLOYMENT (ENGINEERS)  
REGULATIONS 1952, AMENDMENT NO. 1**

**ORDER IN COUNCIL**

At the Government House at Wellington, this 12th day of August 1953

Present:

HIS EXCELLENCY THE GOVERNOR-GENERAL IN COUNCIL

PURSUANT to the Hospitals Act 1926, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, hereby makes the following regulations.

**REGULATIONS**

1. These regulations may be cited as the Hospital Employment (Engineers) Regulations 1952, Amendment No. 1, and shall be read together with and deemed part of the Hospital Employment (Engineers) Regulations 1952\* (hereinafter referred to as the special regulations).

2. (1) Such of the provisions of these regulations as have the effect of increasing the rates of salaries, wages, and other emoluments and increments payable in respect of the classes of persons whose positions are specified in these regulations shall be deemed to have come into force on the 1st day of September 1952.

(2) Except as provided in subclause (1) of this regulation, these regulations shall come into force on the day after the date of their notification in the *Gazette*.

3. Regulation 4 of the special regulations is hereby amended by revoking subclause (1), and substituting the following subclause:

“(1) Subject to the provisions of regulations 5, 6, and 7 hereof, a whole time engineer shall receive a yearly rate of salary according to the scale of salary from time to time determined in each case by the Grading Committee, with the approval of the Minister, that scale being one of the eight following:

4. Regulation 8 of the special regulations is hereby amended by omitting from subclause (2) the expression "£862 10s.", and substituting the expression "£892 10s."

5. Regulation 10 of the special regulations is hereby amended by inserting, after the first proviso to subclause (5), the following additional proviso:

"Provided further that, where any of the above-named public holidays (other than Anzac Day) or substituted succeeding days, where applicable, falls on a day when a shift engineer is normally off duty, an equivalent holiday on a later day convenient to the Board shall be allowed:"

#### EXPLANATORY NOTE

[*This note is not part of the regulations, but is intended to indicate their general effect.*]

These regulations prescribe an additional number of scales of salary for engineers employed by Hospital Boards, and incorporate general increases from 1 September 1952 in conformity with general increases granted in the Public Service following the Arbitration Court's standard wage pronouncement. They also make additional provision affecting annual leave of shift engineers.
