**THE HOSPITAL EMPLOYMENT REGULATIONS 1957,  
AMENDMENT NO. 1**

ORDER IN COUNCIL

At the Government House at Wellington this 17th day of December 1958

Present:

HIS EXCELLENCY THE GOVERNOR-GENERAL IN COUNCIL

PURSUANT to the Hospitals Act 1957, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, hereby makes the following regulations.

REGULATIONS

**1.** (1) These regulations may be cited as the Hospital Employment Regulations 1957, Amendment No. 1, and shall be read together with and deemed part of the Hospital Employment Regulations 1957\* (hereinafter referred to as the principal regulations).

(2) Except as otherwise provided in regulation 3 hereof, these regulations shall come into force on the day after the date of their notification in the *Gazette*.

**2.** Regulation 6 of the principal regulations is hereby amended as follows:

- (a) By omitting from subclause (7) the words "subclause (5)", and substituting the words "subclause (4)";
- (b) By omitting from subclause (8) the words "subclause (5)", and substituting the words "subclause (4)".

**3.** The principal regulations are hereby amended by inserting, after regulation 9, the following heading and regulation:

*"Expenses of Employees on Transfer*

"9A. (1) Where a person employed whole time by a Hospital Board is appointed—

- "(a) To a position in which his salary will be subject to determination by a salaries grading committee; or
- "(b) In such cases as the Minister may approve, to a position in which his salary and other conditions of employment will be determined under regulation 9 of these regulations,—

and is thereby required to move from one locality to another, whether with the same or another Board, he may be granted assistance towards the cost of taking up his new appointment:

“Provided that nothing in this subclause shall apply, unless the appointment is one which in the opinion of the Director-General is an appointment on promotion or is an appointment not involving promotion but in the interests of the hospital service.

“(2) The assistance to be granted shall be subject to such terms and conditions as the Minister may, with the approval of the Minister of Finance, from time to time determine, and, without limiting the general power hereby conferred on the Minister, may include provision for—

“(a) The cost of conveyance of the employee and his family:

“(b) The cost of removal of his furniture and effects:

“(c) Accommodation allowance at the commencement of his journey and on arrival at his destination:

“(d) Expenses during the journey:

“(e) A transfer grant:

“(f) A refund of portion of legal expenses and stamp duties where the person both sells and buys a home consequent upon the appointment.

“(3) The provisions of this regulation shall apply to appointments that are taken up on and after the 1st day of October 1958.”

#### EXPLANATORY NOTE

*This note is not part of the regulations, but is intended to indicate their general effect.*

These regulations include provision for the payment of travelling and other expenses to employees of Hospital Boards appointed to certain positions.
