

THE HOSPITAL EMPLOYMENT (ORTHOPAEDIC TECHNICIANS) REGULATIONS 1952, AMENDMENT NO. 2

HIS EXCELLENCY THE GOVERNOR-GENERAL IN COUNCIL

PURSUANT to the Hospitals Act 1926, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, hereby makes the following regulations.

REGULATIONS

- 1. These regulations may be cited as the Hospital Employment (Orthopaedic Technicians) Regulations 1952, Amendment No. 2, and shall be read together with and deemed part of the Hospital Employment (Orthopaedic Technicians) Regulations 1952* (hereinafter referred to as the special regulations).
- 2. (1) Such of the provisions of these regulations as have the effect of increasing the rates of salaries, wages, and other emoluments and increments payable in respect of the classes of persons whose positions are specified in these regulations shall be deemed to have come into force on the 1st day of April 1954.
- (2) Except as provided in subclause (1) of this regulation, these regulations shall come into force on the day after the date of their notification in the *Gazette*.
- 3. (1) Regulation 4 of the special regulations is hereby amended by revoking paragraph (a) of clause 3 of the Schedule thereto (as substituted by regulation 4 of the Hospital Employment (Orthopaedic Technicians) Regulations 1952, Amendment No. 1), and substituting the following paragraph:

- (2) The remuneration provided for in this regulation shall be subject to the general wage increase prescribed by subclause (2) of regulation 3 of the Hospital Employment Regulations 1952, Amendment No. 1.*
- 4. Regulation 9 of the special regulations is hereby amended by omitting from subclause (2) the words "the next succeeding regulation", and substituting the words "these regulations".
- 5. Regulation 10 of the special regulations is hereby amended as follows:
 - (a) By omitting from paragraph (a) of subclause (1) the word "four" wherever it occurs, and substituting in each case the word "three".
 - (b) By adding to paragraph (b) of subclause (1) the words "for the first three hours, and thereafter at double the hourly rate of pay".

EXPLANATORY NOTE

[This note is not part of the regulations, but is intended to indicate their general effect.]

These regulations contain new provisions relating to the salaries of journeymen and the hours of work and overtime provisions affecting all orthopaedic technicians employed by Hospital Boards.

They also make it clear that meal hours do not count as hours of work for all the purposes of the special regulations.
