

# THE HOSPITAL EMPLOYMENT (OCCUPATIONAL THERAPISTS) REGULATIONS 1957, AMENDMENT NO. 1

## COBHAM, Governor-General ORDER IN COUNCIL

At the Government House at Wellington this 3rd day of December 1957

#### Present:

HIS EXCELLENCY THE GOVERNOR-GENERAL IN COUNCIL

PURSUANT to the Hospitals Act 1926, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, hereby makes the following regulations.

### REGULATIONS

- 1. (1) These regulations may be cited as the Hospital Employment (Occupational Therapists) Regulations 1957, Amendment No. 1, and shall be read together with and deemed part of the Hospital Employment (Occupational Therapists) Regulations 1957\* (hereinafter referred to as the special regulations).
- (2) These regulations shall be deemed to have come into force on the 19th day of November 1956.
- 2. Regulation 4 of the special regulations is hereby amended by revoking the Schedule to that regulation, and substituting the following Schedule:

a yearly rate of salary exceeding £436 but in no case exceeding £487. A rate of salary representing that proportion of the salary payable in respect of full time employment in the position occupied that the number of hours worked during the week bears to forty, such rate to be increased by 10 per cent if the hours worked are thirty or less.

#### EXPLANATORY NOTE

This note is not part of the regulations, but is intended to indicate their general effect.

These regulations prescribe new scales of salaries for occupational therapists employed by Hospital Boards.
