**THE HOSPITAL EMPLOYMENT (OCCUPATIONAL  
THERAPISTS) REGULATIONS 1963,  
AMENDMENT NO. 2**

**ORDER IN COUNCIL**

At the Government House at Wellington this 23rd day of June 1965

Present:  
HIS EXCELLENCY THE GOVERNOR-GENERAL IN COUNCIL

PURSUANT to the Hospitals Act 1957, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, hereby makes the following regulations.

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**REGULATIONS**

1. These regulations may be cited as the Hospital Employment (Occupational Therapists) Regulations 1963, Amendment No. 2, and shall be read together with and deemed part of the Hospital Employment (Occupational Therapists) Regulations 1963\* (hereinafter referred to as the special regulations).

*Commencement*

2. These regulations shall be deemed to have come into force on the 1st day of August 1963.

3. Regulation 4 of the special regulations is hereby amended by revoking the Schedule to that regulation (as substituted by regulation 3 of the Hospital Employment (Occupational Therapists) Regulations 1963, Amendment No. 1), and substituting the following Schedule:
