

THE HOSPITAL EMPLOYMENT (LABORATORY WORKERS) REGULATIONS 1952, AMENDMENT NO. 2

HIS EXCELLENCY THE GOVERNOR-GENERAL IN COUNCIL

PURSUANT to the Hospitals Act 1926, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, hereby makes the following regulations.

REGULATIONS

- 1. (1) These regulations may be cited as the Hospital Employment (Laboratory Workers) Regulations 1952, Amendment No. 2, and shall be read together with and deemed part of the Hospital Employment (Laboratory Workers) Regulations 1952* (hereinafter referred to as the special regulations).
- (2) These regulations shall come into force on the day after the date of their notification in the Gazette.
- 2. Regulation 12 of the special regulations is hereby amended by omitting from subclause (2) the words "the next succeeding regulation", and substituting the words "these regulations".

EXPLANATORY NOTE

[This note is not part of the regulations, but is intended to indicate their general effect.]

The purpose of this amendment is to make it clear that meal hours do not count as hours of work for all the purposes of the special regulations.
