**THE HOSPITAL EMPLOYMENT (X-RAY WORKERS)
REGULATIONS 1957, AMENDMENT NO. 2**

ORDER IN COUNCIL

At the Government House at Wellington this 17th day of December 1958

Present:

HIS EXCELLENCY THE GOVERNOR-GENERAL IN COUNCIL

PURSUANT to the Hospitals Act 1957, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, hereby makes the following regulations.

REGULATIONS

1. (1) These regulations may be cited as the Hospital Employment (X-ray Workers) Regulations 1957, Amendment No. 2, and shall be read together with and deemed part of the Hospital Employment (X-ray Workers) Regulations 1957* (hereinafter referred to as the special regulations).

(2) These regulations shall be deemed to have come into force on the 1st day of April 1958.

2. Regulation 4 of the special regulations is hereby amended as follows:

- (a) By omitting from subparagraph (viii) of paragraph (a) of clause 1 of the Schedule to that regulation (as substituted by regulation 2 of the Hospital Employment (X-ray Workers) Regulations 1957, Amendment No. 1) and also from subparagraph (ix) of that paragraph, the words "subject to paragraph (f) hereof":
- (b) By revoking paragraph (f) of clause 1 of that Schedule.
