PURSUANT to the Primary Products Marketing Act 1953, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, hereby makes the following regulations.

REGULATIONS

1. (1) These regulations may be cited as the Honey Marketing Authority Regulations 1953, Amendment No. 5, and shall be read together with and deemed part of the Honey Marketing Authority Regulations 1953* (hereinafter referred to as the principal regulations).

(2) These regulations shall come into force on the day after the date of their notification in the *Gazette*.

2. Clause (25) of the Schedule to the principal regulations is hereby amended by omitting the word "fourth", and substituting the word "second".

EXPLANATORY NOTE

This note is not part of the regulations, but is intended to indicate their general effect.

The regulations change the date of the election of producers' representatives from the fourth Wednesday in September to the second Wednesday in that month.
