**THE HONEY MARKETING AUTHORITY REGULATIONS 1964,
AMENDMENT NO. 1**

ORDER IN COUNCIL

At the Government House at Wellington this 12th day of July 1967

Present:

HIS EXCELLENCY THE GOVERNOR-GENERAL IN COUNCIL

PURSUANT to the Primary Products Marketing Act 1953, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, hereby makes the following regulations.

REGULATIONS

1. (1) These regulations may be cited as the Honey Marketing Authority Regulations 1964, Amendment No. 1, and shall be read together with and deemed part of the Honey Marketing Authority Regulations 1964* (hereinafter referred to as the principal regulations).

(2) These regulations shall come into force on the day after the date of their notification in the *Gazette*.

2. (1) Subclause (1) of regulation 20 of the principal regulations is hereby amended by omitting the words "of 1/32d. per $\frac{1}{2}$ oz" and substituting the words "at the rate of 0.834 of a cent per lb".

(2) Subclause (2) of regulation 20 of the principal regulations is hereby amended by adding the following paragraphs:

"(d) Any honey packed in containers containing more than 10 lb of honey and sold by a producer by wholesale for re-sale in the containers in which the honey has been packed by the producer:

"(e) Any honey sold by a producer by retail at his apiary packed in the customer's own container."

3. Subclause (1) of regulation 22 of the principal regulations is hereby amended by inserting, after paragraph (c), the following provisos:

"Provided that in respect of honey packed in individual plastic or other containers containing approximately $\frac{1}{2}$ oz of honey, a packer may make a written declaration to the Authority as to the total weight of honey packed by him in such containers over a specified period:

“Provided also that the levy shall be payable to the Authority calculated on the weight of honey so declared by the packer:

“Provided further that containers containing honey on which levy has been paid in accordance with the first and second provisos of this paragraph shall not require to be labelled so as to indicate that the levy has been paid.”

4. Subclause (4) of regulation 29 of the principal regulations is hereby amended by omitting “£1,300” and substituting “\$2,600” and omitting from the proviso thereto the words “one-twelfth of a penny” and substituting the words “0.07 of a cent”.

5. Clause 4 of the First Schedule to the principal regulations is hereby amended by omitting paragraph (ii) of the Table appended to the clause, and substituting the following paragraph:

“(ii) Votes exercisable according to amount of levy paid:

6. Clause 5 of the First Schedule to the principal regulations is hereby amended by omitting “£9 6s. 8d.”, and substituting “\$18.68”.

7. Clause 17 of the First Schedule to the principal regulations is hereby amended by omitting “£3” from paragraph (d) and substituting “\$6”.
